

Deeper Exploration at East Kalimantan Offshore Area



PT Pertamina Hulu Kalimantan Timur (PHKT) keep their commitment to supply oil and natural gas from East Kalimantan offshore.

PHKT was established on 20 March 2018 and officially became an operator for WK East Kalimantan and Attaka on 25 October 2018 until the contract expires in 2038. The fields are Attaka, Serang, Santan, Kerindingan, Melahin, Sapi, Sepinggan, Sejadi, Seguni, Sedandang, Seturian, Yakin, Bangkirai, Mahoni, Pantai, and Lawe-Lawe.

PHKT is also managing mature oil and gas fields that have been operating for more than 50 years. Efforts are being made to maintain production levels, increase reserves, and retain the production decline rate.

In the southern operational area, we support PHKT to improve PCP wells reactivation work reliability using the FANA method, which is using more rigid, simple, flexible frame structure as a substitution for scaffolding to ensure employee safety. This method has been successful in saving operating costs and avoiding potential losses up to hundreds of billions of rupiah per year from oil production lost.

In 2022, PHKT was obtain 9,1 thousand barrels of oil per day (MBOPD) and 35,8 million standard cubic feet of gas per day (MMSC) in average.
